RISK FACTORS

HIGH: Most top draft picks in their first seasons, players with plenty of projection left, players with a significant flaw left to correct, or players whose injury history is worrisome.

VERY HIGH: Recent draft picks with a limited track record of success or injury issues.

EXTREME: Teenagers in Rookie ball, players with significant injury history or players who struggle with a key skill, especially control for pitchers or strikeout rate for hitters.

Jedidiah Marzuq, OF

Born: June 5, 2037 B-T L-L HT: 6'2" WT: 180 Signed as IAFA 2054

TRACK RECORD: Marzuq was signed by Jacksonville as an international amateur free agent out of Kuwait in 2054 with a \$13 million bonus. After three years in rookie ball, he earned a promotion to Short Season A Paraiso, where he hit .257/.323/.341 (83 OPS+) with 22 stolen bases in 26 attempts. He was selected in the first round of the 2059 Rule 5 draft by Montreal, where he hit .227/.255/.356 in his first exposure to pitching above Short Season A. Last season he was assigned to AA Mississauga, where he hit .266/.322/.359 (82 OPS+).

SCOUTING REPORT: Over the past year, Marzuq's offensive projections have continued to rise. Both his hit tool and his power have improved, with scouts now describing both as plus-plus, with elite power into the gaps as well. In addition, his batting eye has developed significantly, now grading out as plus. He has an elite throwing arm and plus-plus outfield range, making him a strong defender at all three outfield positions.

THE FUTURE: Marzuq will remain in AA to start the season.

TRACK RECORD: Makal was signed by Montreal as an international amateur free agent out of Turkey in 2062 with a \$5 million bonus.

SCOUTING REPORT: Scouts project Makal with elite power to all fields and an even better batting eye. He has a plus hit tool although he struggles with strikeouts. Speed is not part of his game, but his defense in right field should be decent enough.

THE FUTURE: Makal has been assigned to Montreal’s international complex.

Born: Sept. 5, 2045 B-T R-R HT: 6’1” WT: 170 Signed as IAFA 2062

TRACK RECORD: Berg was signed by Montreal as an international amateur free agent out of Turkey in 2062 with a \$5.25 million bonus.

SCOUTING REPORT: Scouts describe Berg as a line drive hitter with elite power and otherwise decent tools. Although signed as an outfielder, Montreal intends to work him at the keystone, where he will have much to learn. Team officials say to expect Berg to be a regular in the team’s development lab in future offseasons to work on his defense.

THE FUTURE: Berg has been assigned to Montreal’s international complex.

Born: July 22, 2045 **B-T** S-R **HT:** 6’4” **WT:** 185 **Signed as** IAFA 2062

TRACK RECORD: Agca was signed by Montreal as an international amateur free agent out of Turkey in 2062 with a \$3.3 million bonus.

SCOUTING REPORT: Scouts project Agca with an elite hit tool and plus-plus speed. He is a line drive hitter with decent power and an average eye at the plate. He should be a plus-plus left fielder although his arm is below average.

THE FUTURE: Agca has been assigned to Montreal’s international complex.

Manny Burgus, LF

Born: Feb. 2, 2040 **B-T** L-L **HT:** 6'0" **WT:** 175 **Drafted:** 2059 (2nd round).

Was 11

TRACK RECORD: Burgus was taken in the second round of the 2059 amateur draft by Montreal. Prior to the draft, he detrimentally completed training to improve his base stealing technique at the Central America Conquistadors development complete. Initially assigned to rookie ball, he earned a promotion to Short Season A in mid-season after hitting .350/.425/.700 in 40 games. He continued to hit at the next level, recording a .316/.388/.434 slash line (125 OPS+) in 85 plate appearances.

He was assigned to Single A Dearborn Heights to begin 2060, but earned a promotion to AA Mississauga after hitting .351/.434/.558 (168 OPS+) in 39 starts. He continued to excel in AA, hitting .302/.365/.517 in 293 plate appearances. Last season at AAA New Jersey, Burgus hit .325/.407/.474 (129 OPS+).

During the recent offseason, Burgus successfully completed training to improve his defense in left field.

SCOUTING REPORT: Burgus projects as an extra base machine, with plus-plus power into the gaps mixed with elite speed. His other tools are all slightly better than average. His below average arm strength restricts him to left field, but he has plus range and projects as a plus-plus left fielder defensively.

THE FUTURE: The plan is for Burgus to start in left field for Montreal this season, pushing Clancy Lee to right field. After last season's right field debacle, the club is counting on Burgus as an upgrade both offensively and defensively. Montreal believes that his elite speed combined with his power into the gaps should play well in Ubisoft Field, which is known to be extra base friendly.

Teddy Bullock, LF

Born: Nov. 16, 2038 **B-T** L-L **HT:** 6'1" **WT:** 185 **Drafted:** 2056 (1st overall).

TRACK RECORD: Bullock was drafted first overall in the 2056 amateur draft by Brooklyn, earning a \$9 million signing bonus out of high school. In April of 2060, he was claimed off waivers by first New Orleans and then Montreal. After three years in rookie ball with Brooklyn's affiliate, he split time in 2060 between Montreal's rookie and Short Season A teams, hitting .327/.367/.535 (146 OPS+) and .221/.274/.298 (60 OPS+), respectively. Last season he split time between Short Season A Nassau and Single-A Dearborn, hitting .268/.321/.548 (149 OPS+) and .247/.341/.342 (88 OPS+), respectively. During the offseason, Montreal assigned him a personal trainer / life coach; reports are that Bullock has a renewed sense of purpose and a much-improved work ethic.

SCOUTING REPORT: Bullock was originally drafted for his promise of light-tower power. The power is still there, but scouts say that his poor work ethic has held him back. He projects to have an average hit tool with plus power into the gaps and a plus batting eye. He struggles with strikeouts as he sells out for the long ball. His base running is below average, but he is a plus defender in left field.

THE FUTURE: Bullock is out of options. The former underachiever will now have to work on his game under the bright lights of the BBA. For now, he'll be the last guy on the bench, not the ideal situation for a young prospect. It's a giant leap from Single-A Dearborn to Ubisoft Field. Perhaps Montreal's big league coaching staff can work their magic with him.

7 José Gros, 1B

Born: May 5, 2043. B-T R-R HT: 6'3" WT: 190 Drafted: 2060 (9th round)

TRACK RECORD: Gros was selected out of high school in the ninth round of the 2060 amateur draft by Montreal. In his first two years in professional ball, he has divided time each season between rookie ball and Short Season A; he hit well in rookie ball (146 & 186 OPS+) and poorly in Short Season A (50 & 14 OPS+).

SCOUTING REPORT: Gros was drafted as a second baseman but Montreal moved him to first base. He has a plus hit tool, decent gap power and baserunning skills, but is otherwise unremarkable. These credentials might be good enough for second base, but he will need to level up before he has any hope of playing first base in the big leagues, particularly in a system full of first basemen like Montreal's.

THE FUTURE: Gros will remain in Short Season A Nassau.

TRACK RECORD: Bin Umayr was signed out of Lebanon as an international amateur free agent last May for a \$1,800,000 bonus. He was assigned to Montreal’s international complex.

SCOUTING REPORT: Bin Umayr rarely strikes out. His hit tool and home power project as slightly above average with his gap power and batting eye roughly average. Signed as a second baseman, the Blazers have moved him to first base.

THE FUTURE: Bin Umayr turned 20 years old in January, earning him a ticket to Oshawa to join Montreal’s rookie league team.

TRACK RECORD: Bin Haddad was signed out of Afghanistan as an international amateur free agent last April for a \$1,200,000 bonus. He was assigned to Montreal’s international complex.

SCOUTING REPORT: Bin Haddad rarely strikes out. His hit tool and home run power project as slightly above average. His batting eye is below average. Signed as a second baseman, the Blazers have moved him to first base.

THE FUTURE: Bin Haddad will remain in Montreal’s international complex.

10 Harry Stewart, RHP

Born: June 5, 2040 **B-T R-R HT:** 6'6" **WT:** 190 **Drafted:** 2057 (2nd round).

Was 4

TRACK RECORD: Montreal drafted Stewart in the 2nd round of the 2057 draft, 60th overall. The Blazers farm system is weak in pitching, and Stewart found himself making his first professional start in Short Season A at the tender young age of 16 (two days short of his 17th birthday), surrounded by grown men. He made 12 starts, pitching to a 5.09 ERA (91 ERA+), but allowed only a single home run in 63⅔ innings pitched. At 17, Stewart made 21 starts in Single-A with 12 quality starts, but with a 5.48 ERA and 5.7 walks/9. The following season Stewart mastered Single-A, starting 19 games, going 5-4 with a 2.97 ERA (134 ERA+). The next season in AA, Stewart went 16-7 in 27 starts with a 3.23 ERA (126 ERA+). Last season, he started 24 games for AAA New Jersey, going 8-12 with a 4.43 ERA (105 ERA+).

Stewart completed training in Montreal's development lab in an outstanding manner to improve his control during the recent offseason.

SCOUTING REPORT: Stewart is a right-handed sidewinder who is particularly effective against right-handed batters. With his arsenal of six pitches, however, he is also effective against lefties. His best pitch is his plus fastball. The rest of his repertoire grades out as average. All his pitches move, making it difficult to square him up. Since last season's Handbook, he has continued to develop but scouting projections have been reduced for both movement and control. He has struggled to control his changeup. His floor continues to be that of a starter at the back end of the rotation.

THE FUTURE: Stewart is on the bubble to start the season in the big league rotation.

Moananani Nana, RHP

Born: June 21, 2040 **B-T** L-R **HT:** 6’2” **WT:** 180 **Drafted:** 2059 (12th round).

TRACK RECORD: Nana was selected out of junior college in the twelfth round of the 2059 amateur draft by Des Moines but released two months later. Montreal signed him to a minor league deal in May of 2060 and assigned him to Short Season A Nassau, where he made nine appearances, going 1-1 with a 0.77 ERA (456 ERA+). Last season, he split time between AA Mississauga and AAA New Jersey. He made 29 appearances for New Jersey, going 6-4 with a 4.15 ERA (113 ERA+) and 12 saves.

SCOUTING REPORT: Nana has a very pedestrian three-pitch repertoire but all three feature plus-plus movement. He has pinpoint control and can throw any pitch on any count. He is a soft tosser who pitches to contact but rarely surrenders the long ball. Scouts speak well of his work ethic.

THE FUTURE: Nana is BBA ready. He may find a role in middle relief in Montreal’s strong bullpen; failing that he will return to New Jersey.

Felipe Valdéz, RHP

Born: Mar. 24, 2039 B-T L-R HT: 6'1" WT: 180 Drafted 2060 (12th round)

New

TRACK RECORD: Valdéz was selected out of college in the 12th round of the 2060 amateur draft by Montreal. In his first season at Short Season A, he made 15 appearances, going 1-1 with a 4.88 ERA (72 ERA+). Last season, he split time between Single A and AA, dominating the former to the tune of a 1.74 ERA in 10 appearances. He struggled with the promotion to AA, going 2-1 in 20 appearances with a 5.70 ERA (73 ERA+).

SCOUTING REPORT: The recent offseason saw Valdéz make great strides. His stuff improved dramatically; both his movement and control also got better. His fastball now sits around 96-98 and grades out as plus-plus with the potential to be elite. His curveball, while still a work in progress, also projects as elite. Scouts praise his work ethic and adaptability.



THE FUTURE: Valdéz will likely take his new and improved stuff out for a spin in AAA.

13 Mario Vick, RHP

Born: Mar. 1, 2042 **B-T** R-R **HT:** 6'2" **WT:** 190 **Drafted** 2061 (11th round)

New

TRACK RECORD: Valdéz was selected out of junior college in the eleventh round of the 2061 amateur draft by Montreal. Last season in Single A, he made 31 appearances, going 6-3 with a 2.25 ERA (178 ERA+).

SCOUTING REPORT: During the offseason, Vick added a new pitch to his arsenal: a sinker. It is below average for now, but that is to be expected. He also throws a decent fastball that sits around 91-93 mph and a changeup that projects to be his best pitch. The key to his future is realizing the movement that scouts project, which they say should be plus-plus. His control grades out as decent. Scouts speak highly of his work ethic and adaptability.

THE FUTURE: Valdéz has earned a promotion to AA Mississauga.

14 António Figueroa, RHP

Born: Aug. 6, 2042 **B-T S-R HT:** 6'6" **WT:** 195 **Drafted** 2059 (3rd round)

Was 14

TRACK RECORD: Figueroa was selected out of high school in the third round of the 2059 amateur draft by Montreal, after which he was assigned to Short Season A Nassau. He appeared in nine games, throwing 17 innings to a 2.60 ERA (140 ERA+), allowing no home runs. In the 2059 offseason, he successfully completed training to improve his slider at Montreal's development complex. During 2060, he split time between Short Season A and Single-A. He dominated in the younger circuit, appearing in 33 games with a 1.93 ERA (190 ERA+). He struggled after his promotion, making 34 appearances with a 6.67 ERA (62 ERA+). Last season, he made 57 appearances for Single-A Dearborn Heights, going 6-9 with 30 saves and a 4.99 ERA (80 ERA+), striking out almost eight batters per nine innings, but struggling with his control.

SCOUTING REPORT: Figueroa is an imposing 6'6" classic fastball/slider power pitcher, with an elite fastball sits between 99-101 mph. Scouts project him to have plus movement on his pitches but say that he needs to work on his control. Coaches note that he can be slow to pick up new ideas.

THE FUTURE: Figueroa will likely return to Single-A Dearborn Heights and attempt to harness his triple digit fastball.

New

TRACK RECORD: Brown was selected out of high school in the tenth round of the 2061 amateur draft by Montreal. Last season in rookie ball, he hit .263/.353/.398 (117 OPS+).

SCOUTING REPORT: Brown was drafted as a left fielder but given his poor foot speed and an arm even too weak for left, Montreal moved him to first base where his height will play up. His calling card is his elite contact skill; he very rarely strikes out. Otherwise, his bat projects as roughly average. He is a switch hitter who is equally comfortable from either side of the plate. Scouts suggest that he is not a hard worker and worry that that will impede his development. He is already older than his high school cohort.

THE FUTURE: Brown will move up to Short Season A Nassau.

TRACK RECORD: Chavarría was selected out of high school in the third round of the 2060 amateur draft by Montreal. Assigned to rookie ball, he hit .164/.225/.288 (41 OPS+) in his first exposure to professional baseball. Last season in rookie ball again, he improved to .190/.270/.392 (88 OPS+).

SCOUTING REPORT: Scouts project Chavarría with plus power and a plus hit tool, although he struggles with strikeouts. He can play a respectable left field, but his natural home is at first base.

THE FUTURE: Chavarría will return to rookie ball.

TRACK RECORD: Rojas was signed out of Colombia by Montreal in late 2061.

SCOUTING REPORT: Scouts project Rojas to have elite power as well as a decent hit tool but say that his plate discipline is poor and that he struggles with strikeouts. He has plus-plus speed and plus baserunning instincts. He projects as a plus-plus defender in left field.

His pitching repertoire features decent movement and average command. 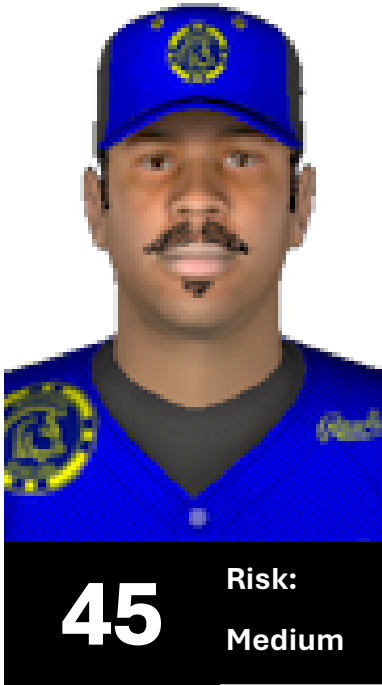
